Simple instructions for creating your college site!

Where do I go?

- Journeys.Dartmouth.Edu
- Select “Create a Site”

What do I do next?

- Under “Site Name” choose your site name—your URL. Most people use their first name, middle initial, and last name with no periods and ending with 26.

- Under “Site Title” enter the name you want to have appear on your home page (currently your site has “NAME” as a placeholder)

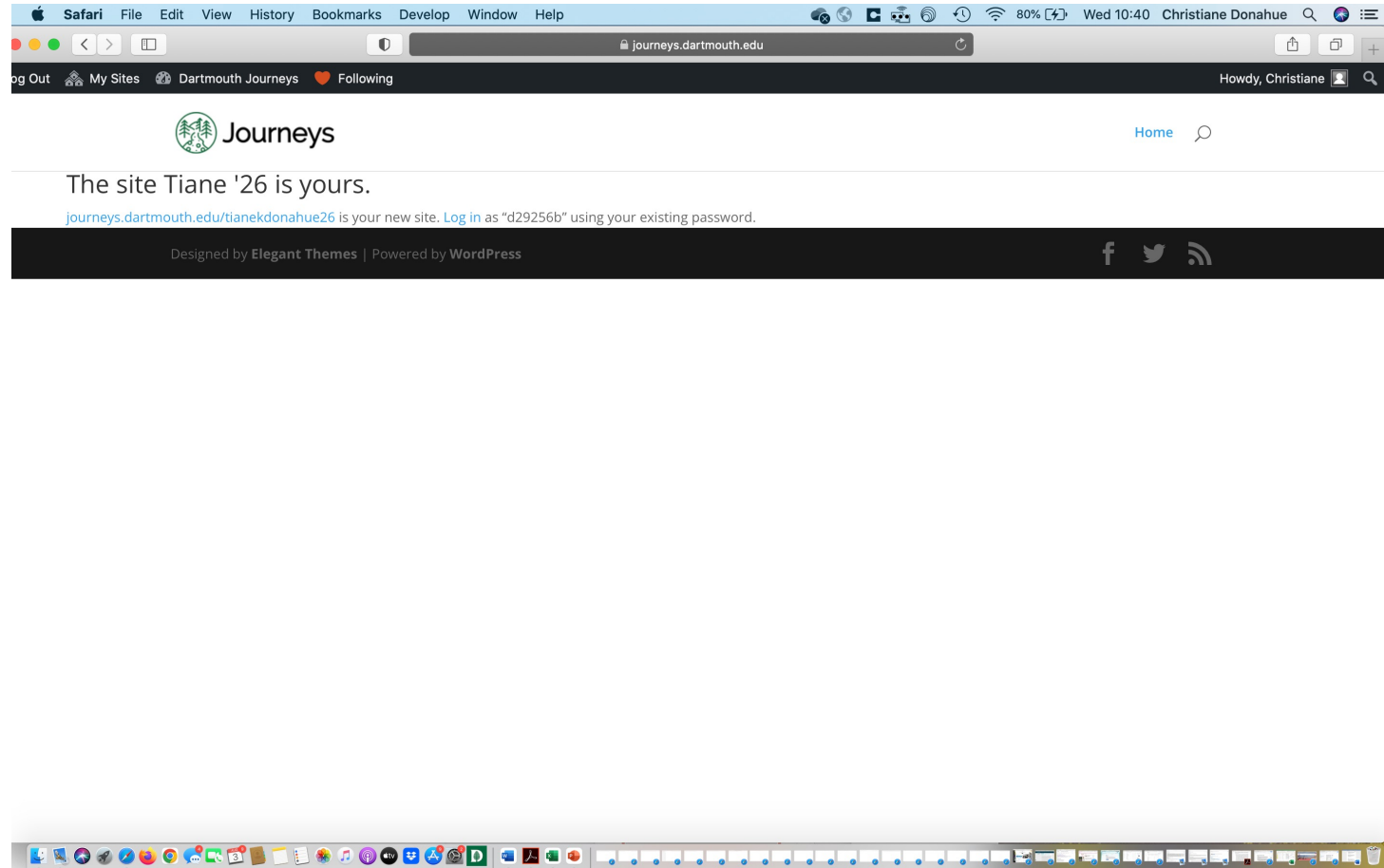

- Under “Privacy” set your site to “Visitors must have a login” which means only Dartmouth community members can see it. You can change this later to more private or more public settings.
- Under “Select a Template” choose “DartWrite 2026s”
- Click “I agree” to Terms of Service

Then what do I do next?

- Click “Create Site” and your site will be created. You’ll see a screen that says “this site is yours” with the URL. It will ask you to log in.

And then?

- Then you'll be at a screen indicating that the site is being created. This takes just a minute.
- When creation is finished, you'll automatically be taken to the "Dashboard" of your new site.

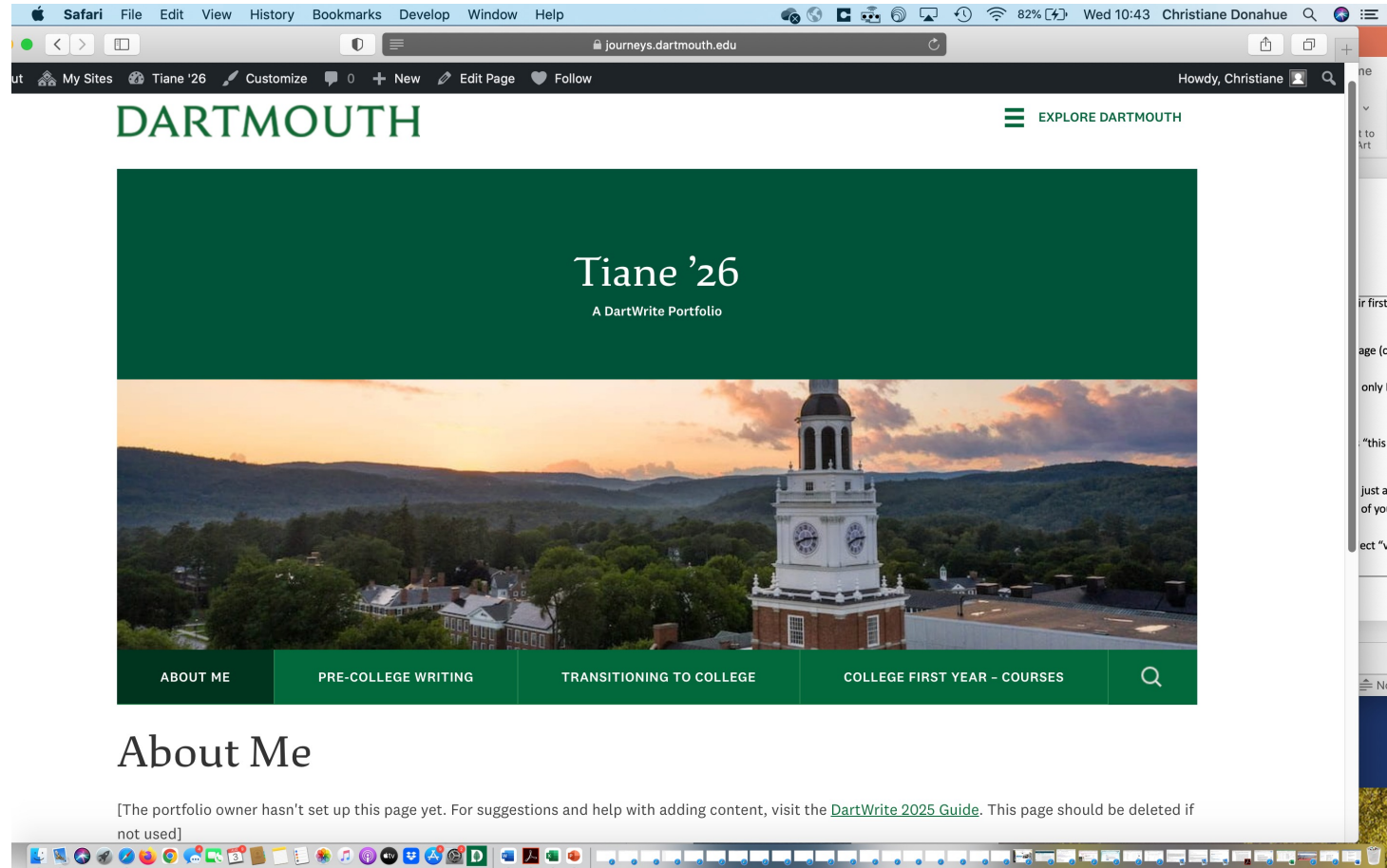
